Intro

The resurrection is the central tenet of the Christian faith. Yet, since the time of Paul, people have been denying the resurrection (v.12-13).

What are the consequences if there is no resurrection (v.14-19)?

"But Christ has been raised"! (v.20) – History's greatest hoax or best ever news?

Evidence that Jesus has been Raised

- 1. The empty tomb is a historically validated fact.
- 2. The matter-of-fact account in the source material.
- 3. The first witnesses were women.
- 4. Other eyewitness accounts.
- 5. The changed lives of Jesus' followers.

Why the Resurrection Matters

Those who place their trust in the Risen Christ:

- are no longer in their sins (v.17)
- are not lost even after they have died (v.18)
- are most blessed because they have a hope that outlasts this life (v.19)
