Introduction

Love – the greatest virtue (Col. 3:14, 1 Cor. 13) and the deepest need of the human heart.

In a fallen world of scams and empty promises, who can we trust?

We can Trust in God's Love because of:

1. **His Promises (c.f. Isa. 7:3-9)** God's love is a faithful love.

God's love is gracious love.

2. His Sign (Isa. 7:10-16)

Signs are visible representations of a deeper reality, usually a promise of God.

Signs are given to assure people that what God has promised he will fulfil.

Response

Choose to trust God, believe in his promises, and reject other loves.

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. (2 Cor. 1:20)
