^{Rom 1.18} The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

Rom 1.21 For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened.²² Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools²³ and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like a mortal human being and birds and animals and reptiles.²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another.

Rom 1.25 They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.

In Rom 1.21-28, we see three movements in Paul's argument: 1. Vv. 21–24: People *"exchange"* the glory of God for idols—God *"gave them over"* to sexual impurity.

2. Vv. 25–26a: People *"exchange"* the truth of God for a lie—God *"gave them over"* to shameful lusts.

3. Vv. 26b–28: People *"exchange"* natural sexual practices for the unnatural—God *"gave them over"* to a depraved mind to do what ought not to be done.

3 truths I shared:

- 1. Homosexual acts are sinful manifestations of rebellion against God the Creator. Other sinful acts are equally sinful.
- 2. But forgiveness and wholeness are found in Christ for all of us.
- 3. Our identity is defined by Christ, not by our sexuality. We are called to be holy and to love others.
- 4. The community of faith is involved.

3. Nuances of SSA

- 3 essential nuances:
- a) Homosexual attraction (tendency).
- b) Homosexual acts.
- c) Homosexual activism.

377A. Any male person who, in public or private, commits, or abets the commission of, or procures or attempts to procure the commission by any male person of, any act of gross indecency with another male person, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 2 years.

- SG as a secular state



On the other hand...


- Proxy for conservative values regarding marriage and family, education etc
