Samuel was born in Hong Kong and became a Christian in 1976. He started to attend a church in Hong Kong and was baptised in the same year.

When Samuel was in his teens, he served the church in supporting roles such as PA and event organising, but God wanted to make known to other people that it is by His grace that we can serve Him in different areas. When Samuel was 19, he was sent by God to spend more than 1 hour travelling by bus to serve at one of the satellite centres that needed someone to lead. Since then, he knew that he needed to spend more time in Bible study and prayer to equip himself to be able to do the work of God.

He served God faithfully in the different areas of the youth ministry for more than 16 years before he and his family migrated to Singapore in 1996 and became Singapore citizens after 3 years. He helped the church he was attending then to set up a welfare arm and a Senior Day Care Centre. In 2010, he started work as a supervisor in St Luke's ElderCare and he is now the Senior Manager at its headquarters managing the Referral & Admission Unit.

Since Samuel migrated to Singapore, God has prepared him to serve the elderly even though this was not his cup of tea. He started attending The Bible Church (Chinese Ministry) in 2012 and transferred his membership to The Bible Church in 2013. Samuel has also been serving in the Chinese Ministry committee since 2015 and he desires to bring together the congregation and have more bonding time with them. He enjoys reaching out to newcomers and helping them assimilate into the church community. He is presently serving in Sunday Worship, teaching in Sunday School for CM & leading a CARE group.

As Samuel has been working in the eldercare sector for 14 years, he realised that the Singapore government already has a new direction for the Eldercare Model to improve the health outcomes of seniors living in the community. There is a need for volunteers to help the Active Aging Centre to provide different community activities and reach out to all the seniors with no or limited social networks to provide befriending and buddy support. For the last Christmas Party and Chinese New Year celebration event, we have reached out to more than 200 seniors in the community. He prays for God to lead the Church to know how we can make a greater impact to the community.

Samuel has been a Church Council member since 2017. He and his wife, Glory Ho, have two daughters, Holly and Phoebe.

EXTRACT FROM THE CHURCH CONSTITUTION

SECTION VIII ELECTION OF THE CHURCH COUNCIL

1. *Conditions for Election*

To qualify as a candidate for election to the Church Council a member must be at least 21 years old and have been a member for at least 3 years and must satisfy the requirements for deacon or deaconess as laid down in the Bible.

2. *Method of Election*

- (a) To nominate a candidate for Church Council election, a member must have five seconders and acquire the written consent of the nominee.
- (b) A member can only either nominate or second just one candidate in any one election.
- (c) The Church Council shall consist of not more than 15 members who received the highest number of votes cast, subject to each having received at least two-thirds of the votes cast.
- (d) Elders shall be appointed unanimously from the Church Council members by the Council. Council members who are not appointed elders shall be deacons of the Church.

3. *Term of Office*

Every elected Church Council member shall serve his or her term of office for 2 years or until the date the Annual General Meeting in the second year of his or her term of office is held, whichever is later, and shall be eligible for re-election.

陈常茂于香港出世，1976 年信主，并在同一年洗礼加入教会。

少年时期的常茂在教会的服事主要是负责音响和主办活动，但上帝想要人知道靠着祂的恩典，我们可以在不同领域服事祂。于是在常茂 19 岁的时候，他被上帝差遣到离他家一个小时车程的教会的卫星中心去带领那里的卫星聚会。自此以后，他知道需要花更多时间研读圣经和祷告，以装备自己来完成上帝的工作。

在接下来的 16 年里，常茂持续在少年事工服事，直到 1996 年他携带家人移民到新加坡，并在 3 年后获得公民权。他帮助当时参加的教会设立了一个福利部和一个乐龄日间护理中心。2010 年他在圣路加乐龄中心担任主管，现在是该中心总部的高级经理，负责管理转介和招生部门。

自从移民新加坡，上帝就预备了常茂来服事年长者，即使这一块不是他喜好的。他在 2012 年开始参加圣经教会的华语崇拜，并在一年后转会。自 2015 年起他就加入中文事工委委会，他的负担是把会友团结起来，彼此有更多的团契。他也喜欢接触新朋友，因为他认为把他们容纳入属灵的大家庭是很重要的。常茂也担任中文事工的崇拜主领、教导主日学，以及带领小组。

由于常茂在老年护理领域工作了 14 年，他意识到新加坡政府已经为老年护理模式制定了新的方向，旨在改善社区中老年人的健康状况，而现在急需志愿者来帮助积极老龄化中心提供各种社区活动，并接触到那些没有或社交网络有限的老年人，且为他们提供陪伴和伙伴支持。在去年圣诞派对和春节庆祝活动中，教会已经接触了社区约 200 多位老年人。常茂祈求上帝引领教会，让教会知道如何在社区中产生更大的影响。

常茂自 2017 年起就担任教会的执事。他与妻子何丽华育有两名女儿，分别为皓霖和朗晴。

教会章程摘录

第八条 教会执事会选举

1. 选举条件

要有资格成为教会执事会的选举候选人，会员年龄必须至少 21 岁，拥有至少三年的会籍，并且必须满足圣经中对执事的要求。

2. 选举方式

- (a) 要提名执事会选举的候选人，提名人必须有五名会员附议，并得到被提名人的书面同意。
- (b) 会员只能在任何一次选举中提名或附议一名候选人。
- (c) 教会执事会应由不超过 15 名得票最多的会员组成，而且每名成员必须至少获得三分之二的选票。
- (d) 长老应从教会执事会中由成员一致任命，未获委任为长老的成员则担任教会的执事。

3. 任期

每名当选的教会执事会成员的任职为两年或直到在任第二年常年会员大会召开为止，视何者为后，并且有资格连任。
