2. <i>Embracing the eternal life.</i> If Jesus has the power of resurrection, how are you focusing on the eternal life, rather than the life here and now?
3. Love in obedience. If Jesus sacrificed himself to save us because of love, how are you loving God and loving others while obeying his commandments?
