"It is crucial to observe the fulfillment of all these preliminary events [in vv.4-28] prior to AD70. This fulfillment will explain how 24.34 can be true. It demonstrates that everything necessary for Christ's return was accomplished within the first generation of Christianity, so that every subsequent generation has been able to believe that Jesus could come back in their times."
