## A Recap on Parables

- In Matthew 13, parables present different imageries of the Kingdom, challenging readers to respond.
- "...if the hearer brings to it the <u>right attitude and openness</u>, will result in their perceiving and responding to the truth" (France, 509)
- As disciples of Christ, we need to respond with a teachable spirit and an open heart.

# Challenge to Respond

Given the following pictures of the Kingdom, how then should "Kingdom people" live?

- 1. The Parables of the Hidden Treasure and the Pearl (v44-46)
  - The man and the merchant sold everything they had and bought the field/pearl.
  - A Kingdom of infinite worth.

Response: Are we prepared to forsake everything else in pursuit of Kingdom priorities, mindset and values?

- 2. The Parable of the Net (v47-50)
  - Good co-existing with evil till the end of the age.
  - Separation at the final judgment.
  - Consequence for those who have lived wicked and unrepentant lives.

Response: Do we live out an authentic faith that endures?

- 3. The Parable of the House Owner (v51-52)
  - Understanding the teachings of the Old Testament in the light of Jesus' Kingdom teachings.
  - A Kingdom for all
  - Those who Jesus welcomed into the Kingdom included the "sinners", the irreligious, those considered unclean, etc.

Response: Is the Bible Church a community for all, including the broken, rejected and marginalized?
